**B DIVISIONS:** If you have titled in Master you have to enter Master B. If you enter any B division, you must stay in that division for the entire event. For more descriptions of B divisions please see the rulebook.

**Collars and Leads- IMPORTANT**

Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dogs MUST run “naked,” without a collar/harness. **NO** flexi-leads allowed.

**Bitches in season**

Bitches in season (BIS) MAY compete at Barn Hunt trial. They will be run at the end of each class. **Bitches in season must wear pants**

**Height Divisions**

- Dogs 13" and under, small
- Dogs 13.1 to 18", medium
- Dogs over 18", large

**Awards**

Each division and height group will have awards through fourth place based on the elapsed time of marking the rat tube. Title rosettes will be awarded to dogs finishing a title. Fastest Dog in each division will receive a special prize and rosette.
