Purpose: To recognize single outstanding achievements by an Australian Terrier and its owner. Recognizing achievements will encourage members to attempt different venues and thereby it gets the Aussie out and recognized by people.

A new committee has been formed called the "OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT COMMITTEE" which also includes the Henderson Award. This award is open to all ATCA members, domestic and foreign.

General:

Awards will be issued on a calendar year starting with 2019. The awards will be certificates of recognition unless otherwise stated. Awards may be distributed at the ATCA Annual meeting. Awards are for ATCA members only.

The chairman will be appointed by the ATCA President and confirmed by the ATCA Board bi-annually in even years. The chairman may select as many ATCA committee members but no less than 3 shall serve on this committee.

Guidelines:

- ATCA member must apply for the Outstanding Achievement Award by completing the Outstanding Achievement Award Form.
- The Outstanding Achievement Award Form must be submitted to the Committee by January 31 of each year listing the achievements for the previous year. The Committee will be the final approval.
- The Henderson Award will be listed separately with its own requirements and with its own Form.
- Examples of some achievements but not limited to: (If you have achievements not listed, please submit to the Outstanding Achievement Committee for determination.)
 1. Australian Terrier to receive the first title in a titling event

2. Different levels of achievement in the same venue – ie., OTCH, MACH 2, UDX3, MXP2, OM7, RM3 – etc.
3. Top Aussie in Obedience
4. Top Aussie in Rally
5. Top Aussie in Agility
6. Top Aussie in any event that measures the success of the dogs
7. Youngest or oldest Aussie to receive a title (this may change periodically as a younger or older dog may come along)
8. Number one Aussie in conformation for breed only
9. Number one Aussie in conformation - Owner Handled for breed only
10. Best in Show Aussie
11. Reserve Best in Show Aussie
12. Obedience -- High In Trial or High Combined
13. Rally – High Combined or High Triple Q
14. Scent Work – High In Trial or High Combined
15. Special recognition by AKC for a specific achievement with an Aussie
16. Henderson Award – see the following for total definition of that award.
